

## 5-Year Quran Hifz Curriculum (15 Juz)

With Meaning & Strong Foundation – For Absolute Beginners

### Program Objectives

This five-year program is designed for students who have never memorized the Qur'an before. By the end of the

program, students will have memorized 15 Juz of the Holy Qur'an with proper Tajweed, understood the basic

meanings of the verses, and developed strong Qur'anic character and discipline.

### Year 1: Foundation Year

Hifz Target: Juz 30 (Juz 'Amma)

Focus Areas:

- 1 Arabic letters, pronunciation, and Makharij
- 2 Basic Tajweed rules
- 3 Memorization of short Surahs with accuracy
- 4 Basic word meanings and themes of Surahs
- 5 Daily Duas, Salah practice, and Qur'anic manners

### Year 2: Beginner Hifz Stage

Hifz Target: Juz 29 & 28 (Total completed: 3 Juz)

- 1 Establishing daily memorization habit
- 2 Strong daily revision (Sabqi & Manzil)
- 3 Key Arabic vocabulary and basic meanings
- 4 Practical lessons from memorized verses

### Year 3: Intermediate Hifz Stage

Hifz Target: Juz 26 & 27 (Total completed: 5 Juz)

- 1 Improving memorization strength and retention

2 Advanced Tajweed rules (Noon Sakin, Meem Sakin, Waqf & Ibtida)

3 Surah-wise themes and moral lessons

Year 4: Advanced Hifz Stage

Hifz Target: Juz 20–25 (6 Juz) – Total completed: 11 Juz

1 Increasing memorization pace with accuracy

2 Selected Tafsir-based explanations

3 Imamat and public recitation practice

Year 5: Completion & Consolidation Stage

Hifz Target: Juz 1–5 (First Five Juz)

1 Completion of 15 Juz memorization

2 Multiple full revision cycles

3 Juz-wise and Surah-wise assessments

4 Understanding the overall message of the Qur'an

One-to-one Hifz supervision

2 Daily Sabak, Sabqi, and Manzil system

3 Weekly and monthly evaluations

4 Strong focus on character, discipline, and adab
